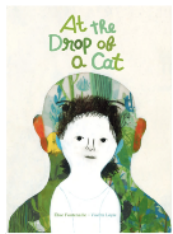

Captivating language, dazzling illustrations and a story that will speak to everyone: Through the power of creativity, Sam shows that all children deserve to be heard, however they communicate.



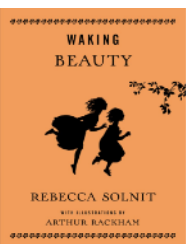

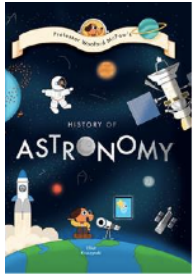

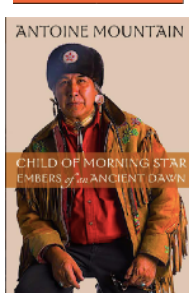
